

Lammas

This is one of the four agricultural services we celebrate. Lammas (from the Old English ,hlafmaesse) celebrates the harvest of the first wheat . We take to church the loaf which is blessed and eaten with Holy Communion. Historically the priest went into the field and cut the wheat sheaf which was made into bread. *Next Page...*

We do not expect John Bundock to have to gather the wheat but will do it for him! The custom was particular to countries in the northern hemisphere, especially in Scotland. It brings it home to us that we live in a society where we decide on our food requirements and just go along to a supermarket. Historically food supply would have been very diminished before harvest of the first grain and the celebration of the first grain was a huge relief.

This festival of Lammas brings it home to us that we should value our wonderful food supplies and celebrate our harvests.

St. Swithun. Shall we get some summer?.

Swithun was a Bishop of Winchester who died in 862 AD. He decreed that he wished to be buried so that passers by could walk over his grave at all times and in all weathers. Later his grave was moved into the cathedral. Following this there was tremendous storm and wind for 40 days until he was moved outside again.

St. Swithuns day is July 15th

Hence the legend and the poem.

"St. Swithuns day if thou dost rain,

For forty days it will remain,

St. Swithuns day if thou be fair

For forty days it will rain no more"

Lets hope St. Swithun and the jet stream work some magic this year!

One defibrillator is stationed at the Stag Pub on the wall to the left of the ladies toilet door. The other defibrillator is stationed at the rear of the cricket pavilion.

They do not require passwords or codes and for ease of use they both have voice instruction on how to use them

Northchapel Defibrillator Location

The defibrillator is located at the top of the Village Green by the notice board. The defibrillator may be accessed in emergencies by phoning 999 who will give you a code for the keypad enabling the door to be opened. Please may all landowners be reminded that they are responsible for maintaining hedges and trees bordering our parish roads. There is much overgrown vegetation throughout the parish and although we have to be mindful of the bird nesting season, if the hedges or trees are causing a serious problem or an obstruction then it is lawful to deal with it.

Likewise with ditches and any watercourse on your land – riparian owners have the responsibility to maintain. If you are not sure where exactly the border of your land is, there are various ways you can find out; from having a chat with your neighbours and checking your property deeds or contacting the Land Registry.

The Wood Carver (Thank you Nathan!)

I saw this piece of wood one day, I picked it up and it seemed to say, there's something hiding inside of me, remove some chips and you will see.






The Cleaning of St Michael's Church


We appreciate that Saturday mornings are not always easy, especially if you have children, but it would be very much appreciated if you could let me know when you would be able to help us.


